Pest common name	Apple stem borer
Regulatory status	Great Britain: Not regulated. Northern Ireland: Regulated quarantine pest.
Pest status in UK (as per ISPM 8¹)	Absent: pest not recorded.
Global distribution	<u>Asia</u> : Afghanistan, China, India, Pakistan
Main hosts	Main hosts: <i>Malus domestica</i> ; <i>Morus indica</i> ; <i>Populus</i> spp. (<i>Populus alba</i> ; <i>Populus ciliata</i> ; <i>Populus deltoides</i> ; <i>Populus nigra</i> ; <i>Populus x canadensis</i> . But also: <i>Debregeasia saeneb</i> ; <i>Ficus</i> spp. (<i>Ficus carica</i>); <i>Maclura pomifera</i> ; <i>Morus</i> spp.; <i>Populus</i> spp. (<i>Populus x generosa</i> ; <i>Populus yunnanensis</i>); <i>Prunus</i> spp. (<i>Prunus persica</i>); <i>Pyrus</i> spp.; <i>Salix</i> spp.; <i>Ziziphus mauritiana</i> .
Likelihood for establishment in UK	Moderately Likely, polyphagous wood boring longhorn beetle which can affect timber quality and weaken trees.
