

UK pest status report for *Adrama* spp.

Pest species name	<i>Adrama</i> spp. Walker, 1859
Pest taxon (order, family)	Insecta: Diptera: Tephritidae
Synonyms	<i>Acanthipeza</i> spp. Rondani, 1875
Pest common name	Tea seed flies A small genus of fruit flies, currently with 18 known species, and at least one (<i>Adrama determinata</i> (Walker, 1856)) is considered a pest in tea plantations in Asia.
Regulatory status	Great Britain: Not regulated. Northern Ireland: Regulated quarantine pest.
Pest status in UK (as per ISPM 8¹)	Absent: pest not recorded
Global distribution	<u>Asia:</u>
Main hosts	Tea (<i>Camellia sinensis</i>)
Likelihood for establishment in UK	Very unlikely, tropical / sub – tropical fruit fly from Asia.
