<b>Main hosts</b>	Fraxinus spp. (ash) including: <i>Fraxinus americana</i> , <i>Fraxinus angustifolia</i> ssp. <i>oxycarpa</i> Franco; <i>Fraxinus excelsior</i> ; <i>Fraxinus lanuginosa</i> .; <i>Fraxinus mandshurica</i> ; <i>Fraxinus nigra</i> ; <i>Fraxinus ornus</i> ; <i>Fraxinus quadrangulata</i> ; <i>Fraxinus rhynchophylla</i> ; <i>Fraxinus uhdei</i> ; <i>Fraxinus velutina</i> ; <i>Fraxinus chinensis</i> ; <i>Fraxinus pennsylvanica</i>
<b>Likelihood for establishment in UK</b>	Very likely to establish and have a significant impact on ash trees.
