Pest taxon (order, family)	Insecta: Lepidoptera: Tortricidae
Synonyms	<i>Platynota chiquitana</i> : Barnes & Busck, 1920
Pest common name	Omnivorous leafroller
Regulatory status	Great Britain: Provisional quarantine pest Northern Ireland: Not regulated
Pest status in UK (as per ISPM 8¹)	Absent: pest not recorded. One interception record of a single live caterpillar on <i>Lantana camara</i> from the USA in June 2004.
Global distribution	North America: United States of America; Mexico. Europe: Spain.
Main hosts	<i>Capsicum annum</i> ; <i>Citrus</i> spp., <i>Dianthus</i> spp. <i>Gossypium herbaceum</i> ; <i>Prunus persica</i> ; <i>Punica granatum</i> <i>Rosa</i> spp.; <i>Rubus fruticosus</i> but highly polyphagous.
Likelihood for establishment in UK	Very likely under protected cultivation (under glass), with high confidence. Outdoor establishment is unlikely with low confidence
