<b>Pest common name</b>	Round headed apple tree borer
<b>Regulatory status</b>	Great Britain: Regulated quarantine pest Northern Ireland: Regulated quarantine pest
<b>Pest status in UK (as per ISPM 8<sup>1</sup>)</b>	Absent: pest not recorded
<b>Global distribution</b>	<b>North America:</b> Canada; United States of America
<b>Main hosts</b>	<b>Main Hosts:</b> Quince ( <i>Cydonia oblonga</i> ); apple ( <i>Malus domestica</i> ). <b>Other recorded hosts include:</b> <i>Amelanchier alnifolia</i> ; <i>Amelanchier canadensis</i> ; <i>Amelanchier laevis</i> ; <i>Aronia arbutifolia</i> ; <i>Betula</i> spp.; <i>Borkhausenia intermedia</i> ; <i>Cotoneaster</i> spp.; <i>Crataegus</i> spp.; <i>Malus coronaria</i> ; <i>Malus domestica</i> ; <i>Prunus avium</i> ; <i>Prunus domestica</i> ; <i>Prunus persica</i> ; <i>Pyrus communis</i> ; <i>Sorbus americana</i>
<b>Likelihood for establishment in UK</b>	Very likely. Suitable hosts are widely grown and there has been an outbreak elsewhere in northern Europe
