Pest common name	Namangan longhorn beetle; willow longhorn beetle
Regulatory status	Great Britain: Provisional quarantine pest (as <i>Xylotrechus</i> spp.) Northern Ireland: Not regulated
Pest status in UK (as per ISPM 8¹)	Absent: pest not recorded
Global distribution	Asia: Afghanistan; China; Kazakhstan; Kyrgyzstan; Tajikistan; Turkmenistan; Uzbekistan.
Main hosts	Main hosts: <i>Alnus glutinosa</i> ; <i>Celtis australis</i> ; <i>Elaeagnus angustifolia</i> ; <i>Juglans regia</i> ; <i>Malus domestica</i> ; <i>Morus nigra</i> ; <i>Platanus x hispanica</i> ; <i>Populus alba</i> ; <i>Populus nigra</i> ; <i>Prunus armeniaca</i> ; <i>Prunus avium</i> ; <i>Prunus dulcis</i> ; <i>Salix alba</i> ; <i>Ulmus minor</i> ; <i>Ulmus pumila</i> . Also recorded from: <i>Betula</i> spp.; <i>Crataegus</i> spp.
Likelihood for establishment in UK	Likely. Suitable hosts are widely grown, though there is some uncertainty over the suitability of the UK climate
