Regulatory status	Great Britain: Regulated quarantine pest (as Begomoviruses) Northern Ireland: Regulated quarantine pest
Pest status in UK (as per ISPM 8¹)	Absent, pest not recorded
Global distribution	South America: Brazil
Main hosts	<i>Capsicum annuum L.</i> <i>Solanum lycopersicum L.</i> <i>Solanum tuberosum L.</i> <i>Capsicum baccatum (pepper)</i>
Likelihood for establishment in UK	Likely based on hosts. Main hosts are commercially grown in the UK, under glass except potato. Virus vector: <i>Bemisia tabaci</i> (<u>tobacco whitefly</u>) is present in Europe but absent (pest eradicated) in UK.
