

## International Forestry Quarantine Research Group Virtual Symposium

The IFQRG-17 symposium will run for 5 days with three, twenty-minute presentations, followed by a 5-minute question period. In keeping with the history and style of IFQRG meetings there will be a general discussion-session at the end of each day. The symposium will be organized by topics, for example: Pest Epidemiology, Pest Detection (e.g. Contaminating Pests), Wood Treatments (e.g. Radio Frequency wood certification, fumigation), Standards and Guidelines Development.
