

Official Pest Report : A new leaf miner pest on table grape in South Africa

Status of the pest: Present, not regulated

Pest Id: *Holocacista capensis*

Host or Article concerned: This leaf miner is newly described as *Holocacista capensis* where it was previously known to be an *Antispila* sp. It is occasionally found on table grape leaves where it cause some damage. It was redescribed after occurrences of damage was reported in the Western Cape.

Other hosts: *Rhoicissus tomentosa*, *R. digitata*, *R. tridentata* and *Cissus cornifolia*

Geographic distribution: Widespread in South Africa
