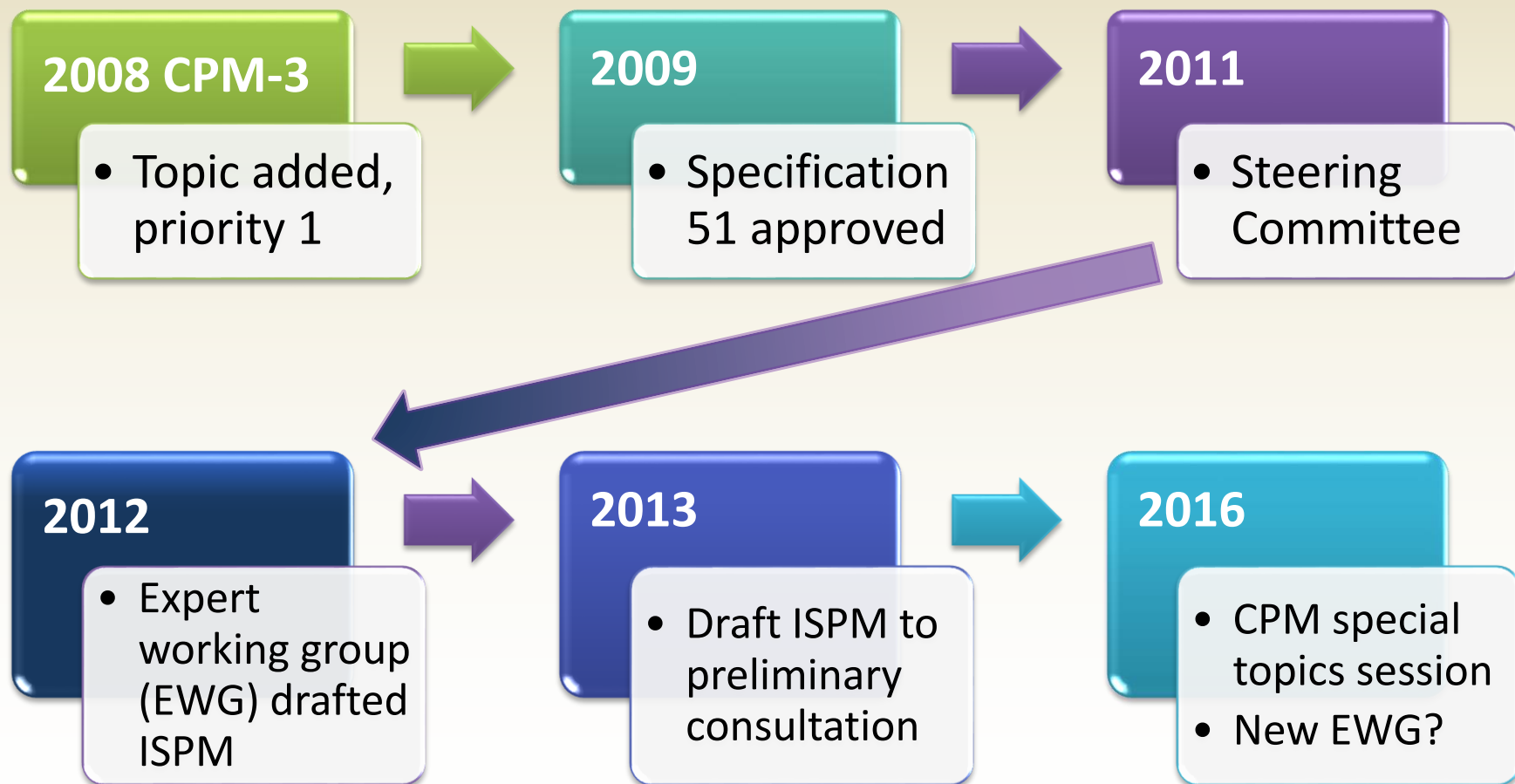

Issues related to the development of the draft ISPM

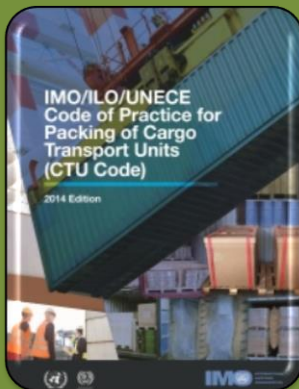
- **Diverging opinions** on how to progress expressed by contracting parties (CPM, 2013 consultation) and Standards Committee members
- Issues to be considered further:
 - ✓ Was proposed as compromise to have **empty containers checked / cleaned in depots**
 - ✓ What **auditing by NPPOs?**
 - ✓ Focus the ISPM on establishing **criteria for clean sea containers?**
 - ✓ **Benefit/incentive** for shipping companies?
