



21 diagnostic protocols under TPDP work programme







1. Expert Consultation on DPs: early stages

- 15 Apr 20 May 2016

- 05 Oct 10 Nov 2016 (tentative)

2. Member consultation: consultation period for all draft ISPMs

- 01 Feb 30 June 2016 (DPs only)
- 01 Jul 30 Nov 2016 (all draft ISPMs)

3. Notification period: final stages

- 15 Dec 2015 30 Jan 2016
- 01 Jul 2016 15 Aug 2016
- 15 Dec 2016 30 Jan 2017
