The SC is responsible for:

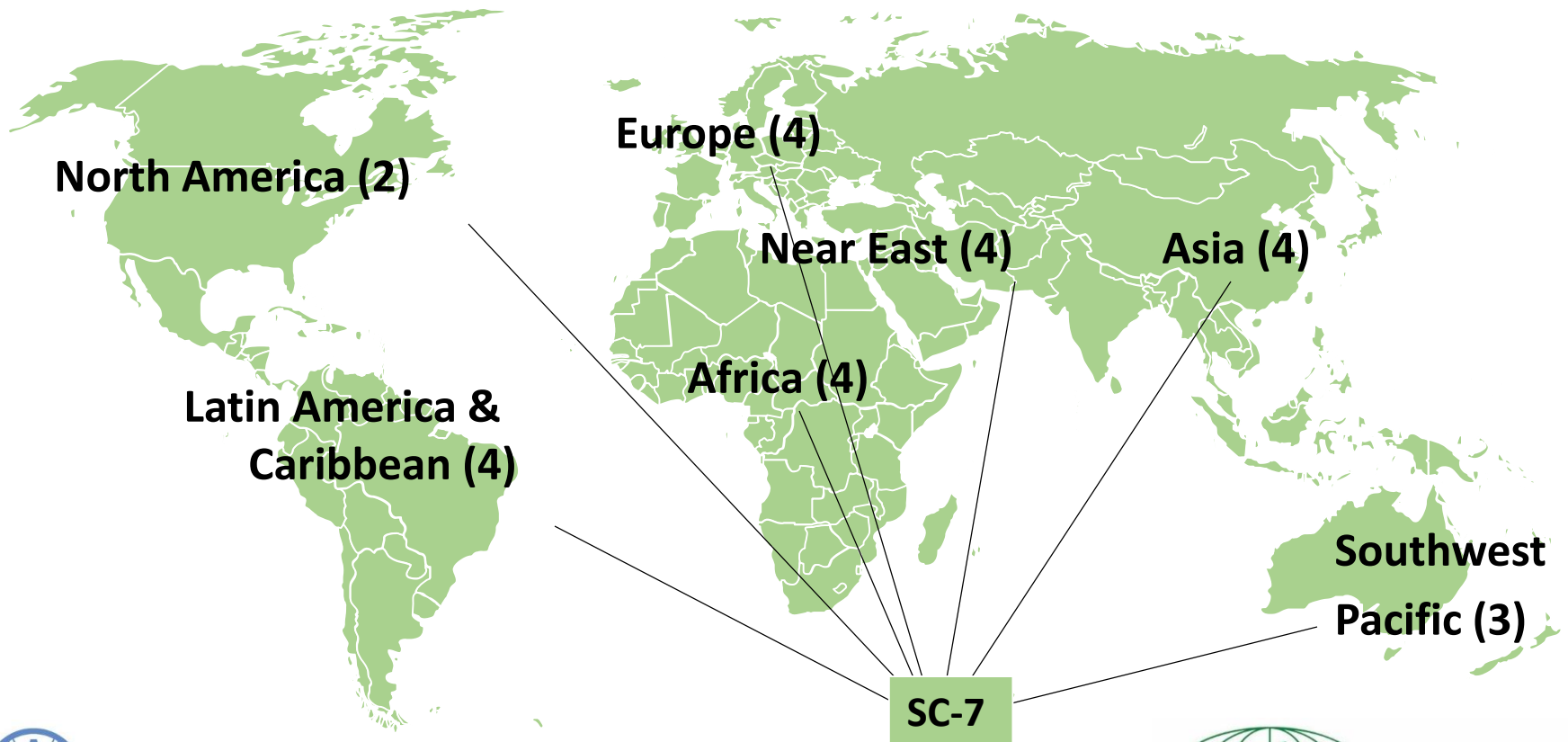
- overseeing the [IPPC Standard Setting Process](#)

## Capacity Development Committee (CDC)

- was composed of technical representatives from the seven FAO regions.
- oversaw the development of tools to strengthen global capacity for implementation of the IPPC.
- served as a steering committee to guide specific capacity development projects.

## Implementation and Capacity Development Committee (IC)

- established by CPM-12.
- composed of 12 members from the seven FAO regions.
- first meeting: December 2017.
- **will develop, monitor and oversee an integrated programme** to strengthen the phytosanitary capacity of contracting parties to implement the IPPC and meet the strategic objectives as agreed by the CPM.
