Background

- ✓ IPPC phytosanitary treatments are critically important to protect plants and plant products while greatly facilitating safe trade
- ✓ Currently there are 31 internationally adopted phytosanitary treatments (Annexes to ISPM 28) – available at the IPPC website

Additional phytosanitary treatments needed to enhance the "treatment tool box" for contracting parties to use to facilitate trade

✓ 2015 November SC decided to open a call in 2017

The International Plant Protection Convention (IPPC) Secretariat is soliciting submissions for:

- ➤1. Phytosanitary treatments to be adopted as international standards, as annexes to ISPM 28 (Phytosanitary treatments for regulated pests)
- ➤ 2. Phytosanitary treatments used in international trade, to be posted on the Phytosanitary Resources page (http://www.phytosanitary.info/)





Call for phytosanitary treatments (con't)

Submission for ISPM 28

- Submissions from Contracting Parties or Regional Plant Protection Organizations (RPPOs) – from their respective IPPC Official Contact Point.
- The Technical Panel on Phytosanitary Treatments (TPPT) will evaluate the submissions and recommend the treatments to the Standards Committee (SC).

Submissions for Phytosanitary Resources page - contributed resources

 Submissions accepted not only from IPPC Official Contact point

• The TPPT will *review* the submissions and recommend the treatments to the Implementation and Capacity Development Committee (IC).





How can you contribute?

The call is open!

If you think that your phytosanitary treatments used in international trade could be available for everyone, please submit them to the IPPC Secretariat.

- Deadline: 30 January 2018 (to be included in the 2018 TPPT meeting) but call is open until resources are available
- Submissions should contain:
 - 1. Completed **submission forms** (available on IPP)
 - 2. Supporting references (research data, publications) or the publication containing the treatment (manual, journal article, legislative document)
