## 1. Sustainable funding mechanism for the IPPC work plan

Financial Committee (FC) of the CPM Bureau has decided to establish a sustainable funding mechanism for the IPPC work plan

#### Background:

- IPPC Secretariat annual budget is USD 6 million
- 50% funded by FAO and 50% by voluntary extra-budgetary contributions from various donors
- Extra-budgetary resources consist of contributions to:
  - IPPC Multi-donor trust fund,
  - IPPC Projects
  - In-kind contributions
- Practically, 50% of total resources are unstable and random and therefore activities are not sustainable

# Sustainable funding mechanism for the IPPC work plan Proposed actions

Financial Committee is proposing:

- 50% of extra budgetary resources to be provided on a more sustainable basis through a mechanism adopted by CPM
- CPM-15 (2020) to adopt a decision on voluntary supplementary contributions based on an assessment criteria that will be established
- In the meantime, contracting parties are invited to continue contributing to the IPPC work plan through traditional channels





# 2. IPPC Work plan and Budget for future years

- Financial Committee (FC) of the CPM Bureau has decided to move the IPPC budgeting process one year ahead
- As a result of this FC decision:
  - CPM-13 (2018) will be invited to adopt transitional 2018 WP and budget as well as the 2019 WP and budget
