

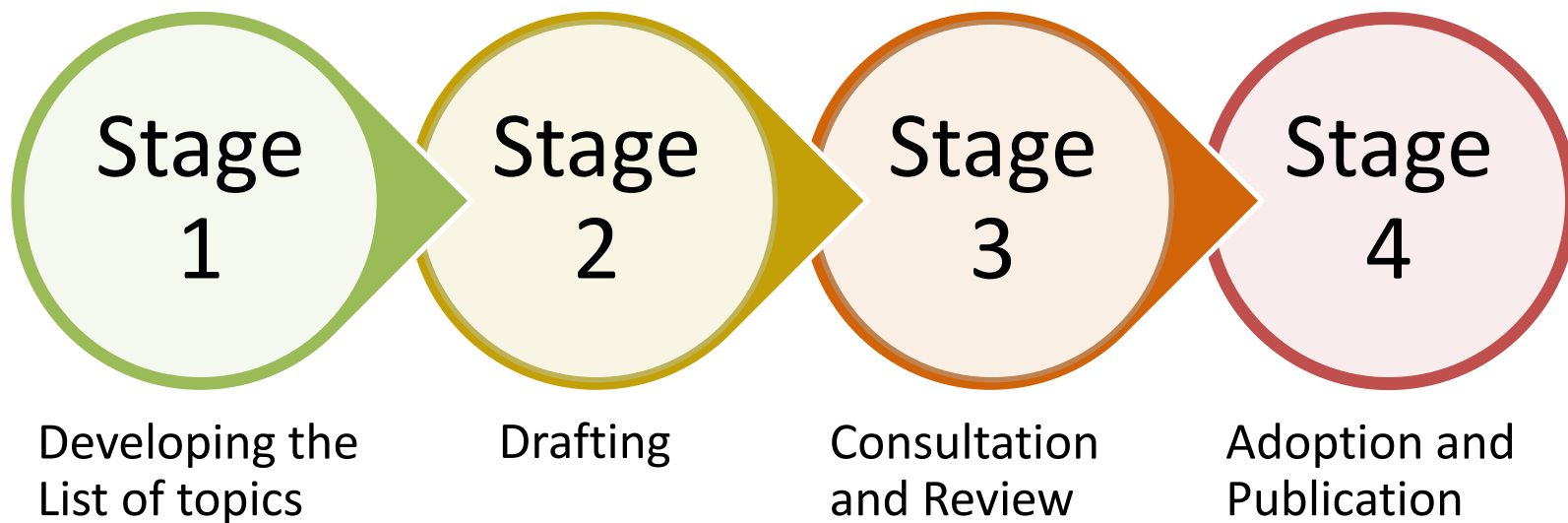

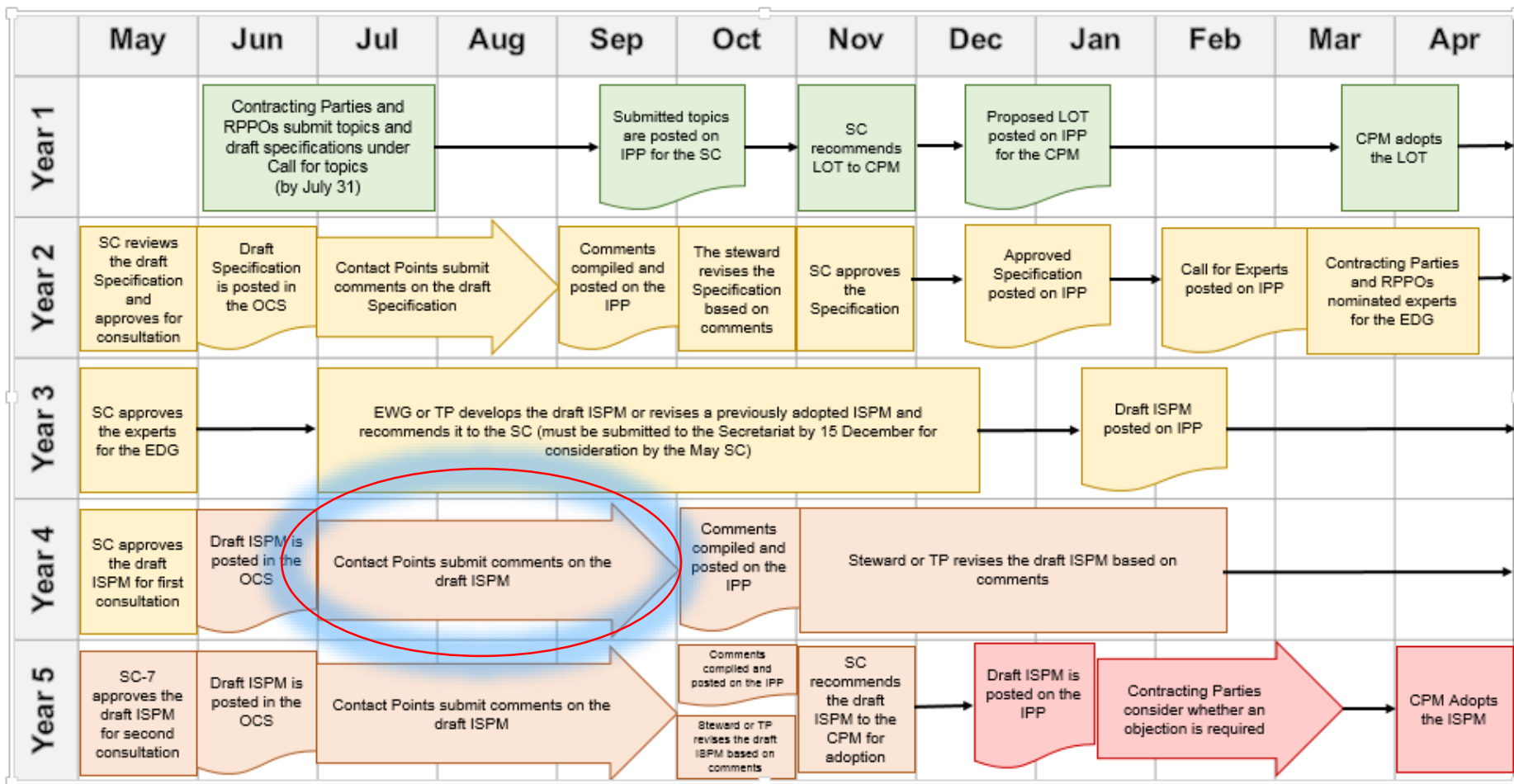

Reading compiled comments and understanding SC responses to them

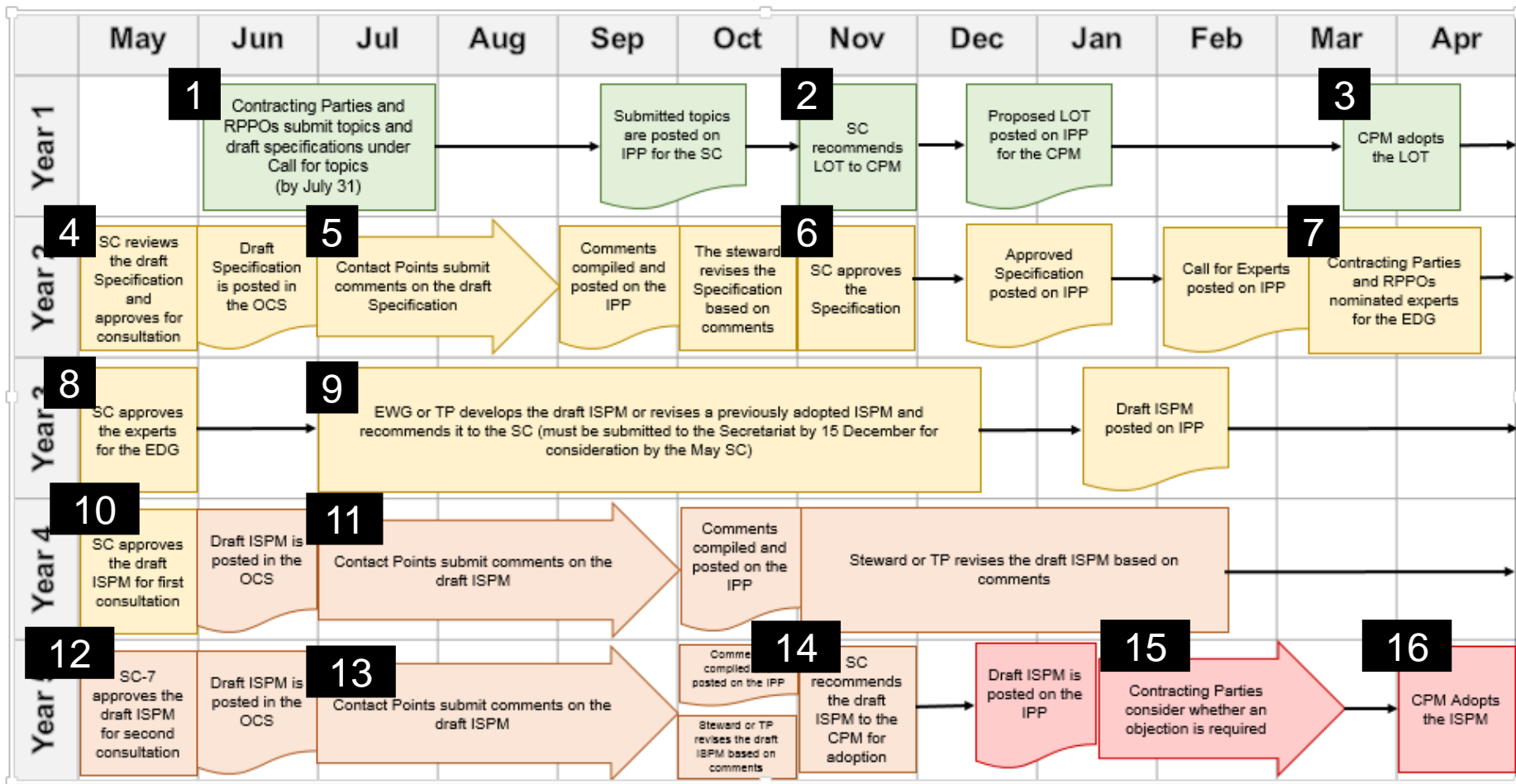
Reading SC reports and discussing issues with SC members

Participating in the DP Expert Consultations

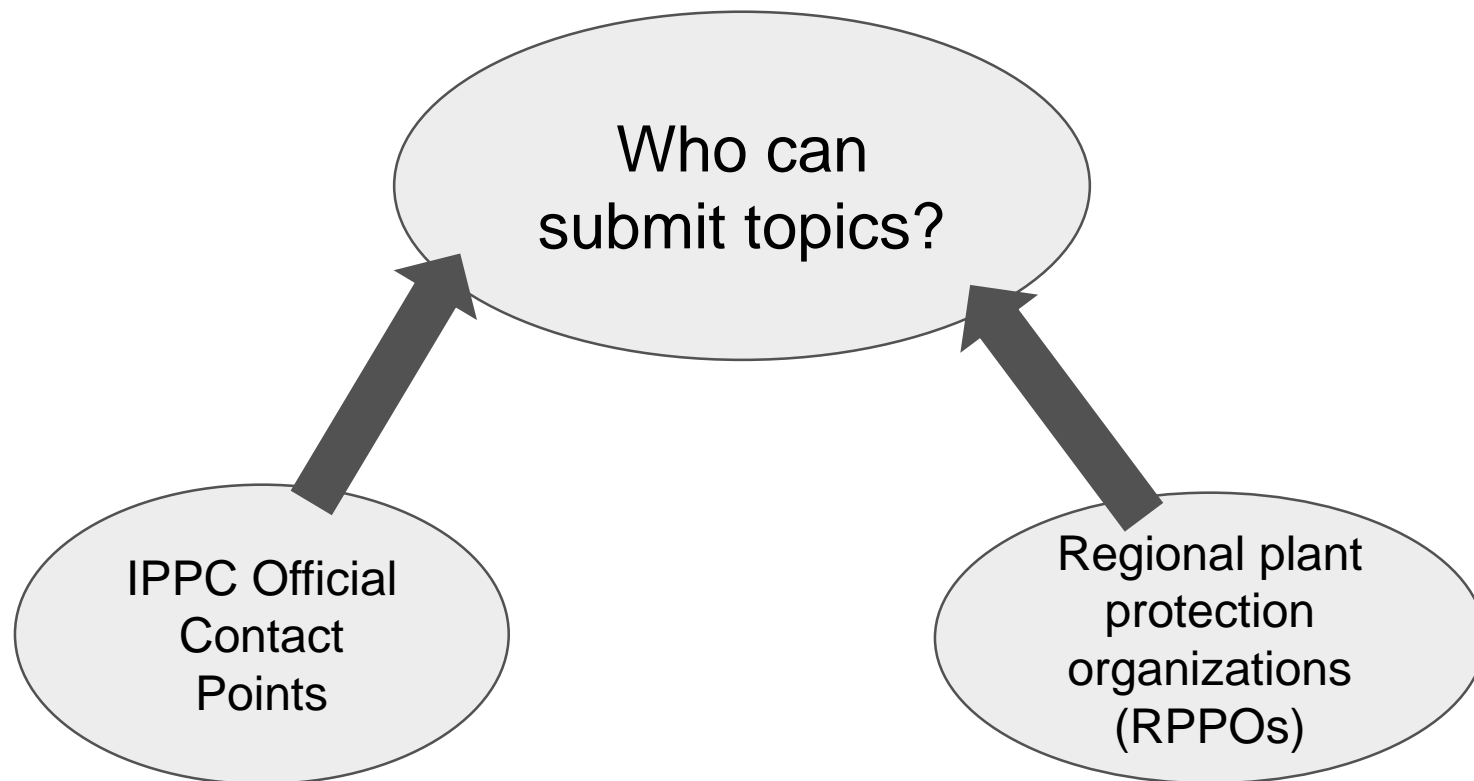
Submitting discussion papers



How and when can you contribute?

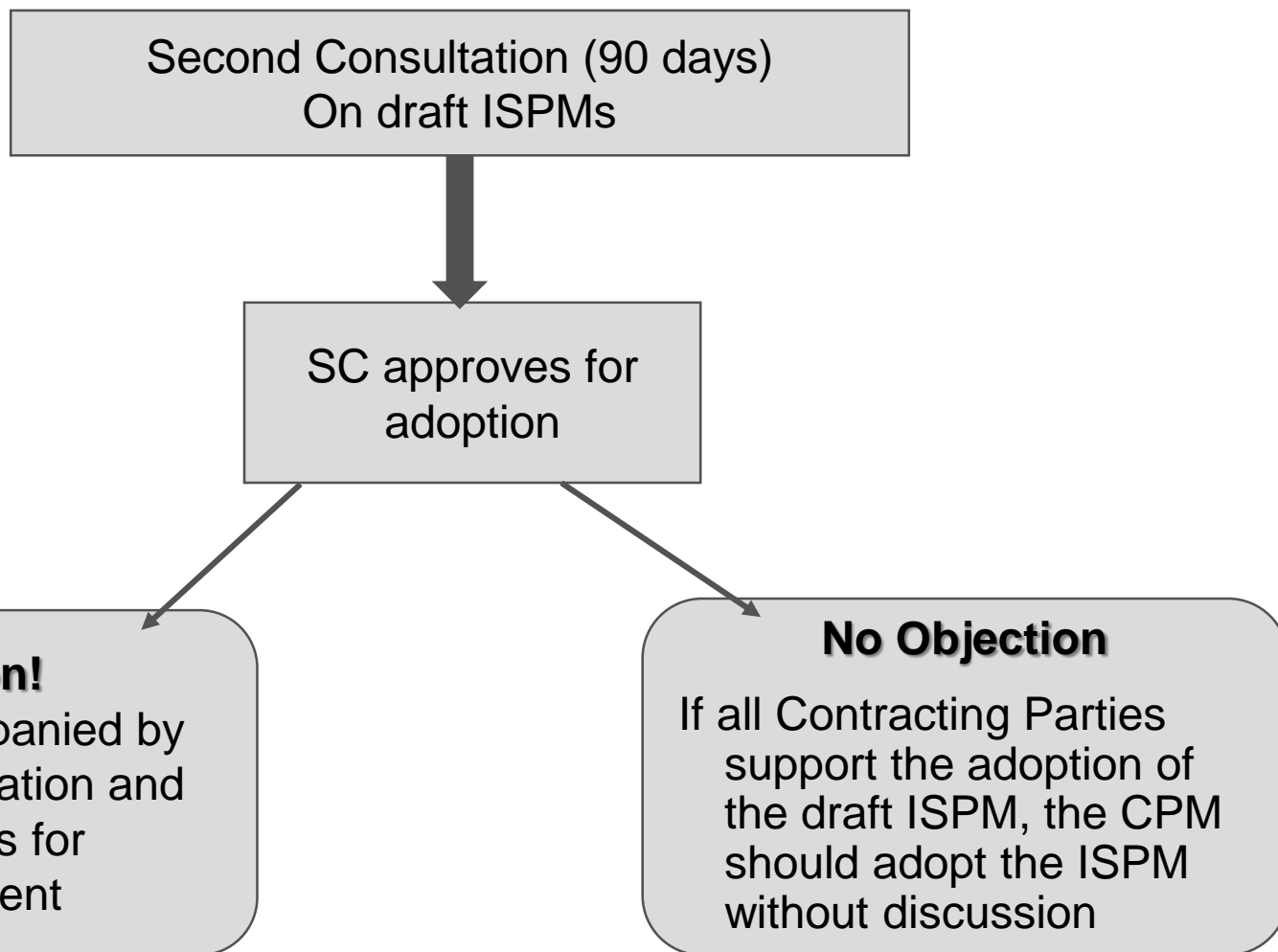


Topics



- The IPPC Secretariat makes a call for topics every two years.
- The last call for topics was in 2015. The 2017 call for topics is delayed pending joint call for topics and other phytosanitary issues.

- Draft Specifications (60 days)
- First Consultation (90 days)
- Second Consultation (90 days)

All starting
1st July



Who do you contact when you want to participate?

- **IPPC Official Contact Point** - topics for standards, comments on standards during consultation, nominate experts to drafting groups, adopting standards
- **Standards Committee (SC) members** – comments on standards at the SC
- **IPPC Secretariat** – expert drafting groups discussion papers
