

# 2017/2018 ACTIONS — FOOD SAFETY MODERNIZATION ACT (FSMA)

- Training in specific rules under the US FDA Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA)
- These workshops are part of the Food Safety and Agricultural Sustainability Training (FAST) programme, which is jointly implemented by IICA and the USDA Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS).
- Lead Instructors training in **Preventive Control in Human Foods** have been conducted in Trinidad and Tobago, Barbados and Jamaica.
- A regional Lead Instructors training in the **Produce Safety Rule** will be conducted in Jamaica in August, 2017

### 2016/2017 ACTIONS – CODEX INITIATIVE

- Continuation of the Codex Initiative
  - Support for attendance to selected Codex Committee meetings
  - Regional virtual meetings on specific Codex standards
  - Chile-IICA Codex Cooperation Project for 5 countries: Strengthening the functioning of the National Codex structure in Jamaica, Guyana, Trinidad and Tobago, Saint Lucia and Suriname. This has been an ongoing action which involves exchange visits between Chile and the five countries. The final activity in this programme will include visits by the Chilean team to each of the five countries between August and September, 2017.

  - Competitiveness and sustainability of agricultural chains for food security and economic development.
  - Inclusion in agriculture and rural territories.
  - Resilience and integrated risk management in agriculture.
  - Productivity and sustainability of family farming for food security and the rural economy.

#### GENERAL COMMENTS

The 10th EDF SPS project sought to strengthen the framework for a modernized AHFS System for the Region such that there is improved SPS compliance and enhanced Trade opportunities within international markets
