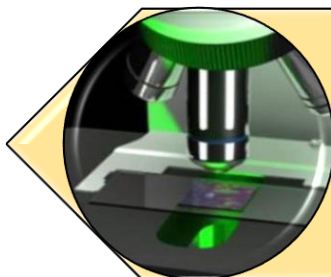

96 adopted standards (1993-2017)



41 standards: import/export systems, phytosanitary certification, pest risk analysis, pest free areas, surveillance, fruit flies, etc



24 diagnostic protocols
targeted as specific pests



31 phytosanitary treatments (irradiation, fumigation, temperature treatments, ...)

IPPC standard setting: future perspectives

- More commodity standards: grain, cut flowers, others...?
- Enabling the use of third party entities
- More phytosanitary treatments for major traded commodities

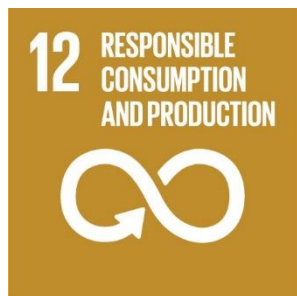
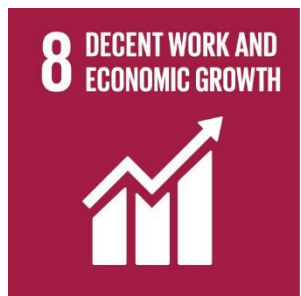
