New RPPO recognized

- **10th RPPO recognized:** Caribbean Agricultural Health and Food Safety Agency (CAHFSA)



IPPC Strategic Framework

- **IPPC Strategic Framework 2020-2030**, out for consultation until 1 September 2018, **presented under agenda 8.7**



Another Framework: Standards and Implementation

- **Framework for standards and implementation:**
2018 version endorsed, request to have both IC & SC champions



Surveillance and NGS Recommendation

- **Implementation Programme on Surveillance**, pilot put on hold until IC and SC analyse results
- **CPM Recommendation** on *The application of Next Generation Sequencing (NGS) technologies for plant pest diagnostics in a phytosanitary context*, under development



Implementation and Capacity Development

- **Report from the IC**, a summary of activities was presented (**also presented under agenda 8.3**) highlighting:
 - DAS, IRSS, NRO and SCTF are now under the oversight of the IC.
 - PCEs, Projects, Guides and training materials, workshops and web resources
- **Implementation Review and Support Systems (IRSS)**, third project cycle started, now under oversight of the IC



Standards

- **Report from the SC**, a summary of 2017 activities was presented highlighting:
 - 13 draft ISPMs and 1 draft specification were submitted for consultation
 - 7 draft DPs were adopted by the SC
 - call for phytosanitary treatments is open, 29 submissions

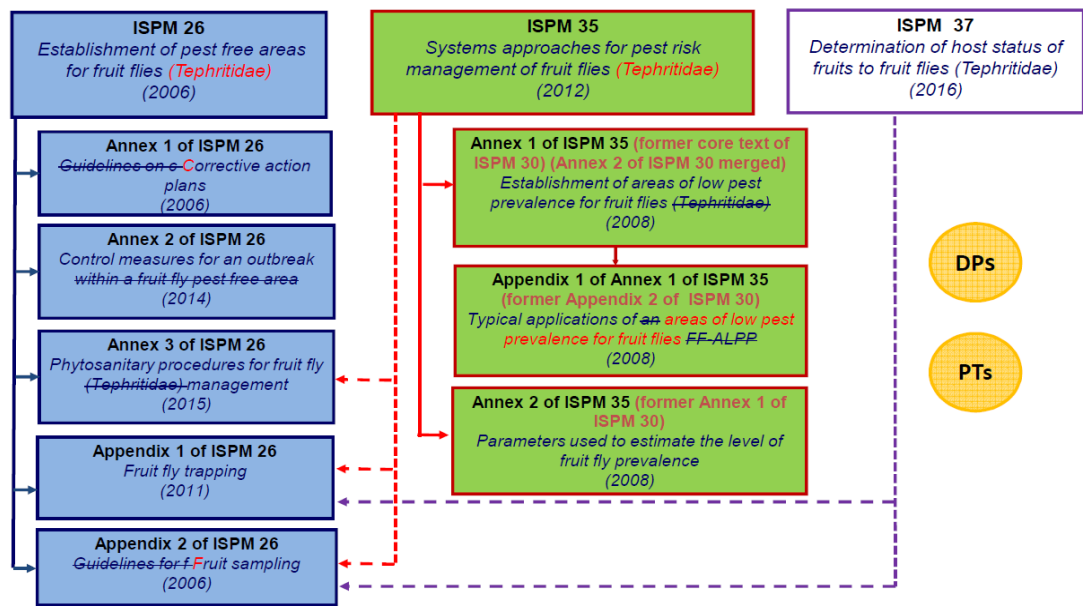


More Standards

- ***Surveillance*** (ISPM 6, revised)
- ***Wood packaging material treatments: sulphuryl fluoride*** (new) and ***dielectric heating*** (modified annexes to ISPM 15)
- ***Temperature treatment requirements*** (ISPM 42, new)
- ***Vapour heat treatment for Bactrocera dorsalis*** (PT32, annex to ISPM 28)
- Noted (adopted by SC):
 - DP 23: ***Phytophthora ramorum*** (new) &
 - DP 24: ***Tomato spotted wilt virus, Impatiens necrotic spot virus and Watermelon silver mottle virus*** (new)

Ink amendments

- *ISPM 5 (Glossary of phytosanitary terms)*, to help ensure the definition of “detention” was consistent with other terms
- *ISPM 12 (Phytosanitary certificates)*, to match up better with e-Phyto
- *Fruit fly ISPMs*, Reorganization, Harmonization and Minor Technical Updates:



ISPM 30 integrated in other ISPM and subsequently revoked – Number to remain empty!

E-Phyto Solution

- **Hub** is now operational, all CPs can join. The Generic National System (**GeNS**), internet based system under development.
- **Requirements** for IT infrastructure, harmonized language, staff training and capacity building were discussed
- Need to inform **stakeholders** on the benefits for trade was expressed.
- Bureau requested to develop a strategy for the sustained operation of the **e-Phyto Solution** with:
 - a five-year implementation plan
 - clear financial governance and
 - suitable business model



IPPC Secretariat Work plan and budget

- Work plan and budget of the IPPC Secretariat for 2018, **presented under agenda 5.2**



Calls

- **Call for topics:** Standards and Implementation, call open until 31 August, **presented under agenda 6.2**
- **Commodity and Pathway standards** (grain & cut flowers) are a challenge still being debated, experts and resources are called for, call open until 31 August, **presented under agenda 6.3**
