- focus of NRO activities: creating, posting and updating regulated pests lists by National Plant Protection Organizations and Official Contact Points
- lists are an important element of safe trade facilitation

Summary

Article VII.2(i) of the IPPC:

Contracting parties should, to the best of their ability, establish and update lists of regulated pests, using scientific names, and make such lists available to the Secretary, to regional plant protection organizations of which they are members and, on request, to other contracting parties



NRO exercise: lists of regulated pests

Summary

International Standard for Phytosanitary Measure No. 5: the Glossary of phytosanitary terms:

A regulated pest is	→	a quarantine pest which is: a pest of potential economic importance to the area endangered thereby And not yet present there or present but not widely distributed and being officially controlled
	→	a regulated non-quarantine pest which is: a non-quarantine pest whose presence in plants for planting affects the intended use of those plants with an economically unacceptable impact and which is therefore regulated within the territory of the importing contracting party

NRO exercise: lists of regulated pests

Summary

- Responsibility for that reporting lies with each contracting party
- It is obligatory for all contracting parties to report their lists of regulated pests



NRO exercise: lists of regulated pests

Summary

Report on lists of regulated pests should be:

- Reported by contracting parties through the International Phytosanitary Portal (the IPP: www.ippc.int)
- Uploaded on the IPP by IPPC Contact Points or their appointed editor/s
- Regularly updated!
