

- **Lead by trained and accredited PCE Facilitators**

- **National Phytosanitary Capacity Development Strategies and work plan are developed to help guide the country to strengthen its phytosanitary system and set priorities.**

- **Later some experiences on the benefits of the PCE will be shared.**


