#### What are the Bilateral NROs

1. Description of organizational arrangements of plant protection

- 2. Rationale for phytosanitary requirements, restrictions and prohibitions
- 3. Reporting of noncompliance with phytosanitary certification

- 4. Reporting the result of investigation regarding significant instances of noncompliance with phytosanitary certification
  - 5. Develop and maintain information on the pest status and make such information available
- 6. Providing the technical and biological information necessary for pest risk analysis.






Figure 1: Total Number of NRO Reports uploaded each year by countries on the IPP





Figure 2. Total Number of NRO Reports uploaded each year by countries on the IPP













# 3. Pest report



When did you or your OCP submitted pest report

#### Pest report

The occurrence, outbreak or spread of pests that may be of immediate or potential danger should be reported via the IPP once they happen.

#### What should be reported under Pest Report

A pest report should contain important information that allows other countries to adjust as necessary their phytosanitary import requirements and to take actions taking into account any changes in pest risk.




# 7. NRO survey
