ePhyto upscaling initiative in collaboration with the IPPC Secretariat

The Global Alliance for Trade Facilitation (the Alliance) worked with Morocco to support it in becoming one of the first countries in Africa to successfully implement the International Plant Protection Convention (IPPC) ePhyto Solution. The international exchange of ePhytos between Morocco and other countries on the ePhyto Hub commenced in March 2020 and Morocco is now one of its most active users.

Building on this success, the Alliance launched an ePhyto upscaling initiative in collaboration with the IPPC Secretariat to support ePhyto implementation in other countries, including Colombia, Ecuador, Jordan, Madagascar and Senegal. The Alliance is currently scoping the potential for support in several additional countries.

The Alliance believes that the IPPC ePhyto Solution is a positive development tool and is keen to support developing and least developed countries in adopting it as a means to replace cumbersome paper-based certification. Alliance partnership with Morocco

The Alliance partnered with the Moroccan National Plant Plant Protection Organization, the Office National de Sécurité Sanitaire des Produits Alimentaires (ONSSA), to undertake a full business process analysis, organise technical visits, train ONSSA officials on ePhyto in collaboration with the UN International Computing Centre, and support technical preparations for the ePhyto pilot. All of the above activities were undertaken with the full support and engagement of ONSSA staff and other supporting agencies.
