Provide updates on its ongoing work and next steps towards the transition to a sustainable IRSS.







Summary

- 40 participants in attendance
 - Mostly from Europe, Asia and Africa
 - Majority were NPPOs (73%)
- Participants' feedback mostly positive (however, only 11 responded to the feedback survey)
 - Most respondents thought the webinar content was very good
 - Most interesting parts of the webinar were the impact of IRSS tools and country experiences

- Most respondents would be interested in attending future IRSS webinars
- A suggestion on future topics for IPPC webinars is on updates on new plant pests and diseases
- Participants learned of the webinar through email from IPPC, through the IPPC news and announcements subscription, and from a colleague



Insights

- A comparatively low attendance can be attributed to the fact that the webinar was more of an institutional webinar rather than the typical webinar that offers discussions on topics and issues, or new learning and materials that participants can apply directly to their work.
- There is generally low awareness about IRSS, hence the webinar did not gain much interest.
- However, the webinar can be viewed as a 'prelude' to the transition to the IPPC Observatory.
- There is an opportunity to improve webinar promotion when launching the IPPC Observatory (see Recommendations)






Recommendations

- Improve content organize webinars that present products to draw greater interest and participation. Think of content that will have value-added to participants, e.g., key results of studies or surveys and their implication to the implementation of ISPMs.
- Tap other channels for further promotion, e.g., EU and potential donors, industry associations, and other organizations.

- Improve and update IRSS webinar page design, interface and content to generate greater interest and engagement.
- Hold joint webinar with other units or programmes to capture a wider audience.
- Presence and support of high-level management (e.g., CPM Bureau, FAO/IPPC) can draw a bigger crowd.
