1. Roles and function of the RPPO in standard setting

- Participation in the development of standards, such as identifying topics for standards and providing comments during the consultation periods;
- Identification of regional standards that should be proposed as the basis for future ISPMs;
- Action as collaborators and assistance in hosting standard setting meetings, as appropriate;

- Preparation of draft explanatory documents on ISPMs
- Provision of technical and administrative support to Standards Committee members;
- Participation of RPPO observers in the Standards Committee meeting



1.1 Role of the RPPO during the Country consultation Process

Coordination and participation in activities **among their NPPOs** in order to promote and achieve the objectives of the IPPC

Cooperation with the CPM and the IPPC Secretariat in developing and implementing international standards for phytosanitary measure... such as providing comments during the consultation periods





2. Importance of the Country Consultation process to Regional Integration

Provides opportunity for all members to participate in the standard setting process


Increased opportunities for **cooperation** with engagement with stakeholder and partners
