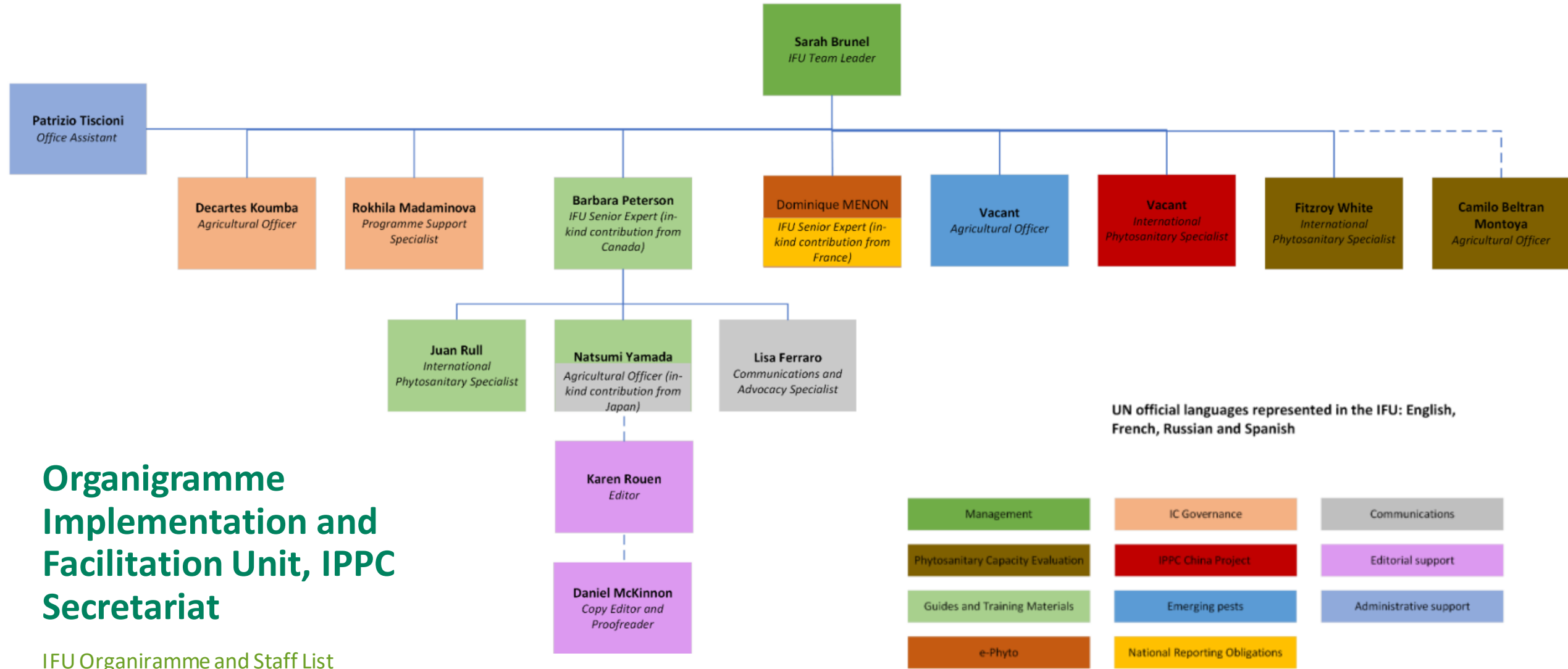


## Session's purpose
