







# Snapshots on Pest risk associated with sea container movements

Animal health and food safety standards related to container cleanliness





### **Terrestrial Code**

Addresses 'containers' in several places, e.g. prior to exportation so indeed the container could be via sea even if a 'container' was within a larger sea container. Mostly related to trade in live animals or poultry hatching eggs.

**Guidelines for Assessing the Risk of Non-native Animals Becoming Invasive** Refers to hitchhiker pests but only in the framework of conducting a Risk Assessment, not specific risk

#### Code of hygienic practice for fresh fruits and vegetables – CXC 53 2003

This document covers more transportation from field to processer and refers to the following text for the onward transportation:

#### Code of Hygienic Practice for the transport of Food in Bulk and semipacked food – <u>CXC 47 - 2001</u>

While this is a bit dated, it does have a section related to transport and food transportation units themselves including the material type, hygienic design etc. this is section 8.4.

## Code of practice for the packaging and transport of fresh fruits and vegetables <u>CXC 44 - 1995</u>

It covers some aspects related to cleanliness especially in <u>2.8 to 2.10</u>. Again, this is somewhat dated and has not been revised for some time.
