### Background Strategic Framework 2020-2030 Development Agenda Items (SFDAs)

- Eight development agenda items of new work aligned with the IPPC's vision, mission, and strategic objectives;
- The IPPC Strategic Framework 2020-2030 is intended to enhance the effectiveness of the IPPC mission;
- Ensure that plans and activities related to the SFDAs receive attention during the 2023 IPPC Regional Workshop;
- Effective implementation and establishment of new SFDAs must be a key focus of the IPPC community and its governing body, the CPM.



Some agenda items are underway and some have yet to be started., i.e. diagnostic lab networking . Some agenda items need to be developed before they can implemented. One of the key things CPM needs to do for example is kickstart the remaining two DAs that have not been started.

7.11 Strategic Framework 2020-2030 Development Agenda Items

**The Strategic Framework 2020-2030 comprises:**

- Mission, vision, three strategic objectives; three core activities and eight key development agenda.
- The three core activities of the IPPC community are:
  - Standards setting
  - Standards implementation & capacity development
  - Communication and international cooperation



### The Strategic Framework 2020-2030 Comprises:

- **Mission** – Protect global plant resources and facilitate safe trade
- **Vision** – The spread of plant pests is minimized and their impacts within countries are effectively managed
- **Goal** – All countries have the capacity to implement harmonized measures to prevent pest introductions and spread, and minimize the impacts of pests on food security, trade, economic growth, and the environment
- **Strategic Objectives** –
  - A. Enhance global food security and increase sustainable agricultural productivity
  - B. Protect forests and the environment from the impacts of plant pests
  - C. Facilitate safe trade and economic growth

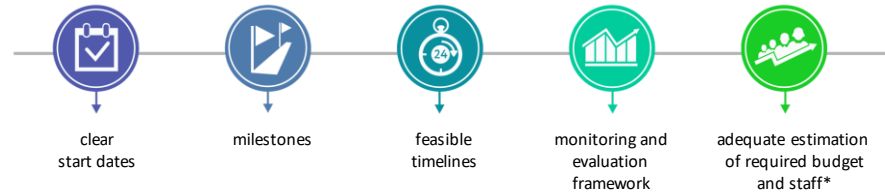
