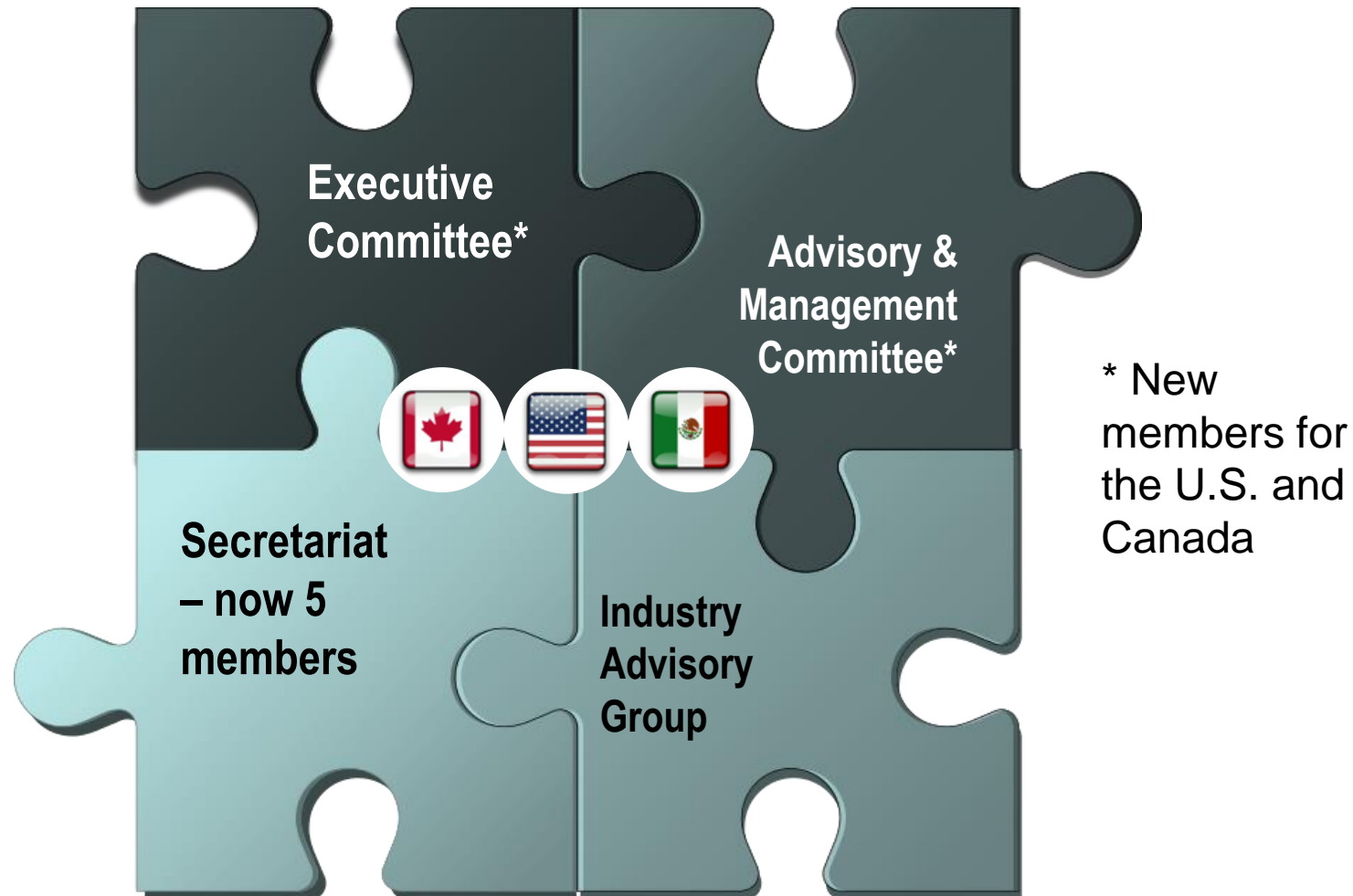

- Asian gypsy moth – *Lymantria dispar asiatica* and other high risk Lymantriids
- Seed transmitted pathogens
- Citrus leprosis

- European cherry fruit fly – *Rhagoletis cerasi*
- Box tree moth – *Cydalima perspectalis*
- Spotted lantern fly – *Lycorma delicatula*
- Tephritidae
