#### REPLACEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CPM 2024/15\_Rev1

The recommendations below replace all recommendations in the original paper CPM 2024/15\_Rev1:

The CPM is invited to:

- 1) *Note* some contracting parties are ready to contribute to the IPPC ePhyto Solution using the proposed model.
- 2) *Note* some contracting parties need more time or want modifications considered to the proposed model to be explored before they can begin contributing to the IPPC ePhyto Solution.
- 3) *Agree* the *Procedures for the IPPC ePhyto Solution Funding Model* as described in Appendix 1 of this paper.
- 4) *Note* country contributions to the IPPC ePhyto Solution are not mandatory for any country.
- 5) *Agree* during the transitional period, reports comparing expected contributions and actual contributions by country will not be presented to CPM (paragraph 23 of the *Procedures for the IPPC ePhyto Solution Funding Model*).
- 6) *Agree* the funding model will be implemented as a transitional pilot and that the funding model will be reviewed after two years (2027) and reported to CPM.
- 7) *Agree* during the transitional period alternative fee structures embedded in the model will be explored.
- 8) *Agree* to extend the term of the focus group on ePhyto funding until CPM 19 and request the focus group explore and report to CPM on alternative modifications and adjustments including those suggested in CPM 18.
- 9) *Request* contracting parties provide any additional suggested modifications to the Secretariat with urgency for consideration by the focus group.
- 10) *Agree* the CPM Bureau will govern the funding model until an alternative governance mechanism is agreed by the CPM.
- 11) *Note* contracting parties wanting FAO to provide funding for the IPPC ePhyto Solution should promote this through their permanent representatives.
