## CHANGES TO DECISION POINTS IN CPM PAPERS

### Introduction

- [1] There have been some changes to draft CPM decision points during the CPM report preparation process. These are listed below.
- [2] Blue text indicates the additions or changes, strikethrough indicates that the point is to be deleted.
- [3] Changes to decision points (per agenda item):
- Agenda 9.2 (IC report), decision point 5 amended the to be procedurally correct: *request that the financial committee consider* the provision of.,.
  - Agenda item 10 (Adoption of ISPMs), decision point 11 has been updated to include acknowledge the contributions of the members of the SC, the TPDP, the TPCS, the TPG, and the TPPT who have left in 2024 *and first quarter of 2025*.
  - Agenda item 12 (IPPC Observatory), the last decision point from item 16.1 has been moved to item 12 (as the second decision) and has been expanded to include the e-commerce survey: *thank all countries that had responded to the IPPC Observatory surveys on antibiotic use, fungicide use or e-commerce for their contributions to a better understanding of the use of antimicrobials in plant health and establishing a baseline for measuring key e-commerce outcomes*.
  - Agenda item 12 (IPPC Observatory), added a new decision point (as the third decision): *note the proposed content of an IPPC Observatory investment prospectus, which will be published on the IPP*
  - Agenda item 12.1 (ePhyto), added a new decision point at end as per usual practice when focus groups end: *acknowledge the contribution of the CPM Focus Group on Sustainable Funding of the IPPC ePhyto Solution and thank the focus group members for their work*.
  - Agenda item 12.2 (commodity standards), added a new decision point at the end, for consistency with other agenda items: *thanked Australia, Canada, the European Union, France, Japan and New Zealand for providing financial or in-kind contributions to support this DAI to date*.
  - Agenda item 12.3 (e-commerce), added a new decision point (as the second decision): *note the preliminary results of the IPPC Observatory on e-commerce*
  - Agenda item 12.5 (POARS), amended the penultimate decision point to be procedurally correct: *request that the Financial Committee consider a funding allocation of USD 50 000 ...*
  - Agenda item 12.6 (climate change), amended decision point 1 to be procedurally correct and added a new decision at the end for consistency with other agenda items: *note the updates from the focus group and approve the action plan presented in appendix 1 and; thank Canada, Ireland and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for their financial support for this DAI*
  - Agenda item 14.1 (plant health campus), decision point 5 was amended to be procedurally correct: *note the translation of most IPPC guides and e-learning courses to French, and request*

- that the Financial Committee consider the provision of USD 50 000 to translate some materials to Spanish"
- Agenda item 14.2 (Update on Plant Health IC projects), amended the decision point 4 (c) to reflect current circumstances: ... c. the project to support the IPPC Observatory activities, ~~to be potentially funded by the European Union~~; and
  - Agenda item 14.3 (PCE), amended the final bullet point to be procedurally correct: *request that the Financial Committee consider the funding allocation requested by the IC of USD 50 000 from ...*
  - Agenda item 19.1 (IPPC Secretariat financial report), decision 3, inserted the yellow-highlighted text for completeness: encourage contracting parties to contribute to the IPPC MDTF (Special Trust Fund of the IPPC), *ePhyto MDTF, APP MDTF* and IPPC projects, preferably on an ongoing basis
  - Agenda item 20.2 (regional communications network), amended the decision point to reflect updated situation so it reads: *note the update on the regional communications network*
