

- Hydrocotyle ranunculoides




Phytophthora ramorum









Survey 2002/2003

- survey 1400 sites with Rhododendron
 and 100 sites with Vaccinium
- 30 infestations found only in Rhododendron
- containment measures
- large infested objects












Dutch elm disease
