
Emerging Pests

- Anastrepha grandis. Support to Panama in surveillance and control of this pest is continued.
- Huanglongbing (HLB). Support to the countries in surveillance and control of this pest and its vector insect is continued:
 - evaluation of national phytosanitary programs
 - trainings in control techniques
 - procurement of citrus germplasm of high genetic value
 - nursery handling
 - diagnostic



Emerging Pests

- Tuta absoluta (outbreak at Panama's Northwest)
 - Regional emergency funds for its control
 - Supply of traps and pheromones to other Central American countries (detection surveys)
 - Submission of protocol for identification of the pest (available at : http://www.oirsa.org/portal/documents/tuta/Protocolo-de-Identificacion-de-Tuta-Absoluta.pdf)









Emerging Pests

- Maconellicoccus hirsutus
 - The condition of the pest in Belize and its consequence in the rest of the Central American countries still free of the pest was discussed
