# Emerging Pests

- ***Anastrepha grandis***. Support to Panama in surveillance and control of this pest is continued.
- **Huanglongbing (HLB)**. Support to the countries in surveillance and control of this pest and its vector insect is continued :
  - evaluation of national phytosanitary programs
  - trainings in control techniques
  - procurement of citrus germplasm of high genetic value
  - nursery handling
  - diagnostic

# Emerging Pests

- ***Tuta absoluta*** (outbreak at Panama's Northwest)
  - Regional emergency funds for its control
  - Supply of traps and pheromones to other Central American countries (detection surveys)
  - Submission of protocol for identification of the pest

- *Maconellicoccus hirsutus*
  - The condition of the pest in Belize and its consequence in the rest of the Central American countries still free of the pest was discussed
