## I. Background

1. During CPM-9 (2014), for the first time, participants were invited to share their successes and challenges in implementing the IPPC and ISPMs. These presentations were favourably received and a standing agenda item was added to the CPM agenda. A news item ${ }^{2}$ was posted on the IPP on 10 December 2014 calling for submissions.

## II. Submissions

2. Ideally, these presentations should be no more than 1-3 pages in length and they should concentrate on issues that would be of interest to all contracting parties. Submissions will be reviewed by the IPPC Secretariat with input from the Bureau. All submissions that meet the above criteria will be compiled into a CPM document. CPM members, from selected submissions, will be requested to make a five minute presentation at CPM-10 (2015).
3. Proposals, along with written text should be submitted to the IPPC Secretariat (IPPC@fao.org) no later than 13 February 2015 (extended from 23 January 2015). Submission should be in one of the six official FAO languages and will be presented in the CPM document in the language received.
