

Requirements/Restrictions/Prohibitions Regulated/Restricted Imports

For all regulated Imports, Biosecurity Authority (BAF) of Fiji issues an Import Permit detailing all import requirements that has to meet by the importer and also the necessary original SPS documentations that needs to furnished for and import.

All import permit requirements for these regulated/ restricted imports are stored in the BAF database. BAF hopes to roll out its new Biosecurity Information Management System (BIMS), which is a fully automated system that will also link to the E-certification that Fiji will be working with other neighbouring NPPO's on import related commodities. The BIMS will also ensure that all import conditions for various Biosecurity regulated items is accessible to the general public for their perusal and information.

This BIMS will link BAF to the Fiji Customs Asycuda system on the imports and Biosecurity risks associated to different import pathways

Prohibitions

BAF carries out Import Risks Assessments (IRA's) and through these IRA's items that are considered high risks are potential prohibited items. These are items that BAF considers in the IRA's that treatment mitigating measures will not be able to consider or address the risks associated with the import consignment.
