

Phytosanitary Legislation

1. General legislation

For imports to and internal control in Greece, the general phytosanitary requirements of the EU apply ([Council Directive 2000/29/EC](#) of 8 May 2000 on protective measures against the introduction into the Community of organisms harmful to plants or plant products and against their spread within the Community).

2. Emergency measures

In addition to EU Directive 2000/29/EC, specific [emergency measures](#) are applicable.

3. Phytosanitary certificates

The models of the Phytosanitary certificates for [EXPORT](#) and [RE-EXPORT](#) are based on the International Standard for Phytosanitary Measures No 12 'Guidelines for Phytosanitary Certificates' adopted under the International Plant Protection Convention.
