## **Phytosanitary Legislation**

## 1. General legislation

For imports to and internal control in Greece, the general phytosanitary requirements of the EU apply (<u>Council Directive 2000/29/EC</u> of 8 May 2000 on protective measures against the introduction into the Community of organisms harmful to plants or plant products and against their spread within the Community).

## 2. Emergency measures

In addition to EU Directive 2000/29/EC, specific <u>emergency measures</u> are applicable.

## **3.** Phytosanitary certificates

The models of the Phytosanitary certificates for <u>EXPORT</u> and <u>RE-EXPORT</u> are based on the International Standard for Phytosanitary Measures No 12 'Guidelines for Phytosanitary Certificates' adopted under the International Plant Protection Convention.
